To register to vote, you must be a United States citizen, a resident of California, 18 years of age or older on Election Day, and not currently imprisoned or on parole for the conviction of a felony.

Have you ever experienced an accident on the jobsite? What did you do? How was it handled by you and others? Here are some suggestions if you have an accident while at work which results in a minor injury. The first thing you should do is to make sure your situation is safe, don't further injure yourself or others. Be aware of your surroundings. Next, report your injury to your Foreman. It is suggested to document when it

occurred. If anyone witnessed the accident, they should report to the Foreman as well. The Foreman should also thoroughly document the situation. Next seek medical attention to treat any injuries. If outside medical attention is necessary, someone such as the Foreman or a designated individual should drive you to the hospital to seek medical attention. It's always a good idea to be familiar with your company policies that relate to accidents. The main point is to be safe in whatever you do.

Statewide Ballot Measures:

Prop. 68: Drought, Water, Parks, Climate, Coastal Protection, Outdoors Protection Act - **SUPPORT**

(\$4 billion for parks and water related infrastructure, and flood protection projects.)

Prop. 69: Motor Vehicle Fees & Taxes; restriction on expenditures - STRONG SUPPORT

(Constitutional amendment ensures new funding created by Senate Bill 1 remains dedicated to transportation.)

Prop. 70: Greenhouse Gas Reduction Reserve Fund (2/3 vote requirement) - NEUTRAL

(Requires State Legislature 2/3 vote on or after 2024 to pass spending plan for revenue from the state's Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund.)

Prop. 71: Ballot Measure: effective date - NEUTRAL

(Statewide propositions would be in effect after the statewide vote has been counted and certified by Secretary of State instead of taking effect the day after Election Day per current law.)

Prop. 72: Property Tax: new construction rain water capture exclusion - NEUTRAL

(Allows the State Legislature to exclude rainwater capture systems added after 1/1/19 from property tax assessments.)




